

New Revised USFAA Awards Nomination Procedures

New forms (May 09) must be used or it will delay your nominations.

The United States Field Artillery Association (USFAA) processes three Field Artillery awards for worthy Redlegs and their spouses: The Ancient Order of Saint Barbara, the Honorable Order of Saint Barbara and the Artillery Order of Molly Pitcher. Each award has specific requirements that must be met before induction. The USFAA awards are unique and special to our members and our branch. To maintain the integrity of these awards, it is essential that nominators and those involved in the approval process adhere to the criteria and uphold the standards for these awards. To do otherwise will deflate the significance of these awards and be unfair to those who have met these criteria and have been presented these awards. Our Board of Directors requires that the Approving Authorities, Nominators and Nominees of the awards be USFAA members in good standing. If the Nominee is not a member, the cost for the award will reflect membership for the individual to the USFAA.

To ensure the potential awardee is not a prior recipient, you may call or email the USFAA before sending the nomination to us. Our database contains the names of most past awardees. All nomination requests must come to the USFAA office. If you have any questions, please call our Awards Department at toll-free (866) 355-4677 between 8am and 5pm Monday-Friday.

ANCIENT ORDER OF SAINT BARBARA

The Ancient Order is the more distinguished of the two levels of the Military Society of Saint Barbara. It recognizes the select few who stand above their brethren of the Honorable Order, who have made conspicuous long-term significant contributions to the branch and who are members in good standing of the USFAA. The specific criterion for accession into the Ancient Order is to have performed conspicuous, for or on behalf of the United States Army Field Artillery or Marine Corps Field Artillery. The Ancient Order is reserved for an elite few whose careers have embodied the spirit, dignity and sense of sacrifice and commitment epitomized by Saint Barbara. The Ancient Order of Saint Barbara is neither a longevity nor rank award. It is reserved for those who truly go above and beyond their required duties as a Field Artilleryman, regardless of rank. Membership in the Honorable Order is not a prerequisite for membership in the Ancient Order. The approving authority for all awards of the Ancient Order of Saint Barbara is the Commanding General, US Army Field Artillery Center and Fort Sill. The Commanding General may approve, disapprove or downgrade the nomination to the Honorable Order, as he deems appropriate. If the Nominee is not a member, the cost for the award will reflect membership for the individual to the USFAA.

HONORABLE ORDER OF SAINT BARBARA

The Honorable Order of Saint Barbara recognizes those USFAA Members in good standing who have demonstrated the highest standards of integrity and moral character, displayed an outstanding degree of professional competence, served the United States Army or Marine Corps Field Artillery with selflessness; and contributed to the promotion of the Field Artillery in ways that stand out in the eyes of the seniors, subordinates and peers of the recipient. If the Nominee is not a member, the cost for the award will reflect membership for the individual to the USFAA. The approval authority for the Honorable Order of Saint Barbara is reserved for USFAA members in good standing who are LTC FA Commanders (when no COL Commander is available.) They may approve the award for those in or associated with their commands. When there is no such FA commander available, the Commanding General of the US Army Field Artillery Center and Fort Sill is the approving authority for the Honorable Order of Saint Barbara.

ARTILLERY ORDER OF MOLLY PITCHER

The Artillery Order of Molly Pitcher recognizes individuals who have voluntarily contributed in a significant way to the improvement of the Field Artillery Community. Approval authority for the Artillery Order of Molly Pitcher is the same as the Honorable Order of Saint Barbara. If no LTC FA Commander or above is available, the Commanding General of the US Army Field Artillery Center and Fort Sill is the approving authority of the Artillery Order of Molly Pitcher. All Molly Pitcher nominees must be a USFAA Member in good standing. Those who are not or whose spouses may not be members, the cost for the award will reflect membership for the individual to the USFAA.

HOW TO REQUEST AWARDS

HONORABLE ORDER OF SAINT BARBARA AND/OR ARTILLERY ORDER OF MOLLY PITCHER

Complete the order form(s) available through the *Artillery Journal* or on the USFAA website (www.fieldartillery.org). The approving authority signs the packet, ensuring the nominated person meets the award criteria. When a COL FA Commander is not available, a LTC FA Commander may approve the Honorable Order of Saint Barbara and the Artillery Order of Molly Pitcher. They may approve awards for those in or associated with their commands or communities. When there is no such FA commander available, the Commanding General, US Army Field Artillery Center and Fort Sill, is the approving authority for the Honorable Order of Saint Barbara. If you do not have a local approving authority, follow the instructions for requesting the Ancient Order of Saint Barbara.

ANCIENT ORDER OF SAINT BARBARA

Follow the procedures listed for the Honorable Order of Saint Barbara, and then include a recommendation letter endorsed by a Field Artillery COL or LTC, in your award submission. There is no special format for this letter. It simply must contain sufficient details about the candidate and his/her significant contributions to the Field Artillery, to enable the Commanding General, Fort Sill, to make an informed decision. You may request a sample nomination letter by calling our office at toll-free (866) 355-4677. Late submissions are not guaranteed to arrive on time due to the unknown schedule of the Commanding General. If the Commanding General decides the justification does not merit the honor, the USFAA will refund 50% of the payment to the requester.

Please provide the mailing address, phone number, e-mail, and USFAA Chapter preference for each individual being nominated. Nominations will not be accepted without this information.

Include payment for the awards. We will not process award requests unless we receive full payment. DISCOUNTS/PENALTIES There is a discount for on-time bulk orders. Payment must be included. There is a **25% penalty** for nominations arriving at the national headquarters *less than one month* before the projected presentation date. There is a **50% penalty** for nominations arriving *less than two weeks* before the presentation date. Shipping fees may be applied to late awards to ensure their on-time arrival.
